

Q: 1. When does admission start?

A: From July 15th, 2023

Q: 2 Who can enroll in nursing Generic BSN program?

A: HSc. (Pre-Medical) with 50% marks minimum (Physics, Chemistry & Biology as compulsory subjects) or equal foreign qualification. Age Limit: 17-35 years, Gender Ratio: Open for male and female test and interview.

Q: 3. Who can apply?

A: Candidates from all over Pakistan are encouraged to apply.

Q: 4. Can International candidates apply?

A: Yes, required A - level or equivalent qualification (IBCC equivalences required)

Q: 5. What is the Generic BSN aimed at?

A: The aim of the Nursing degree programs combine knowledge learnt from the physical and behavioral sciences, informatics, and the humanities and nursing theory and implement it into nursing professional practice. Engage the students in the discovery of knowledge & develop critical thinking skills to solve the problem, of individual, family, & community and use these research findings for evidence-based nursing practice. The curriculum is designed in alignment with local and global health care industry practices which also makes it suitable for students who want to relocate themselves internationally.

Q: 8. What is the program duration of Generic BSN?

A: Generic BSN is 4 years Degree Program (Morning) (8 semesters of 16-18 weeks = 135 credit hours followed by a one-year internship)

Q: 9. What is the structure of the programs?

A: The Sohail University follow the semester system

Q: 10. What is meant by “Credit hours”?

A: Credit hours represent the number of hours a student is required to study a subject. For example, 3 Credit-hour-class teaching means a student is required to study three hours of a particular subject in a week. For clinical and lab, one credit hour is equal to three hours of a particular subject in a week

Q: 11. How will the programs be taught?

A: At Jinnah College of Nursing, the fundamental pedagogical tool is learning by doing (experiential learning) where students are required to participate actively in all curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and clinical duties at attached hospitals and community health centers. Project and case study methods are the major tools which are supplemented by individual and group exercises, role-plays, problem-based learning, simulation exercises, field community visits, lecture-cum discussion by students. Throughout four years of stay at Jinnah College of Nursing, students will actively be participating in conferences, seminars and guest speaker sessions conducted by top-notch professionals in their respective fields. Active participation will allow students to learn from the experts which will ultimately help students build their career effectively.

Q: 14. What does the entry test of generic BSN comprise of?

A: Biology Physics, Chemistry, Math and English

Q: 15. Where is Korangi Campus situated?

A: Sohail Trust Hospital Korangi Campus Korangi Industrial Area near TCS office Karachi.

Q: 16. How to apply at Jinnah College of Nursing Sohail University?

A: Forms are available at admission office of Sohail University at Medicare cardiac & General Hospital Bahadurabad as well as from Jinnah College of Nursing Korangi campus or you can download the admission form from website and send with required documents at Jinnah College of Nursing, Jinnah Medical College Hospital Korangi Campus Korangi Industrial Area near TCS office Karachi.

Q: 17. What is the admission and processing fee?

A: 1500 PKRs Admission processing fee will be charged if any student who wants to apply for more than one programs of Sohail University, 500 extra will be charged for other programs to apply.

Q: 18. What is the refund/cancellation policy? /How do I withdraw from the program and what are the consequences?

A: Students can withdraw from any semester/program but have to pay the fee or pay back the scholarship or any other dues to date. Admission and semester fees will not be refunded. However, policies differ depending on the program to which you have been enrolled. Further please visit the Refund and Cancellations Policy of the university and HEC.

Q: 19. What is the process for submitting admission and processing fee online?

A: You can download the admission form from the Jinnah College of Nursing website <http://www.jcn.edu.pk> & send the form dually filled out accompanied with the required documents and pay order in the name of Sohail University (AC # 0010005042580115) and send the forms at Jinnah College of Nursing postal address Jinnah Medical College Hospital Korangi Campus Korangi Industrial Area near TCS office Karachi.

Q: 20. What is the process of receiving my admit card?

A: You can collect the admit card from Jinnah College of Nursing prior to the admission interview. Only out-of-station candidates can collect their admit cards same day at the time of admission interview on payment of the processing fee from the Secretary College of Nursing

Q: 21. What is the process of submitting fee by bank challan?

A: You can submit the fee by pay order in the name of Sohail University & directly to account department.

Q: 22. What English Language Proficiency tests are required?

A: Proficiency of English will be checked at the time of interview.

Q: 23. Can I apply for the scholarship?

A: Deserving, meritorious based scholarship is available for female and male candidates. Females are encouraged to apply.

Q: 24. Will be transport available to pick up & drop off the students for a short visit or clinical purpose during the program?

A: Transport will be available for official visits of the students in the community or clinical for teaching and learning purposes.

Q: 25. When will I receive a fee voucher for tuition fees & other charges?

A: Students have to pay fees prior to the start of the new semester except for a valid reason. Prior approval from the HOD is required prior to the deadline otherwise late surcharge will be applicable.

Q: 26. May I pay the fee in Lum-sum?

A: Subject to approval from management; however, no any extra favor will be given to the candidates.

Q: 27. How do I transfer credits into my undergraduate institution?

A: It will not be encouraged except for valid reasons; however, students from HEC-recognized and PNC-accredited institutions will be considered. Official transcript and courses studied with course grid required to evaluate. Only 30% of credit hours can be transferred to one program.

Q:28. Will I need to buy textbooks?

A: We have all reference books for the program. Students are issued the books for a specified period of time; however, students are encouraged to buy their own books for their long-lasting learning. Faculty members share the class schedule, course grid and Table of Specification (TOS) at the start of the course, teaching material at the end of the lecture and let them know reference books for their study. It is the students' responsibility to use it. Students can take journals and have online access to learning material

Q: 29. What are learning facilities available for students on Campus?

A:

Q: 30. Is a hostel facility available for students?

A: Only out-of-station female students can be accommodated.

Q: 31. What are the policies related to the code of conduct?

A: Students need to read the laydown policies of Sohail University regarding the students' responsibilities and professional conduct, attendance, and academic integrity and uniform policy at their clinical especially late coming, earlier departing, not following the dress code, use of unfair means and political influence, defamation of institution will not be allowed.

Institute has a zero-tolerance policy for any involvement of students in alcohol and drug use.

Zero tolerance means that if any student is found to use or involve, will be subject to immediate dismissal from the university.

Q: 32. May I bring and use a Smartphone?

A: Smartphone is not allowed during institute timing as well as at clinical. Otherwise, Smartphones will be taken and first time and returned to the student on fine and the second time will not be returned until the end of their program.

Q: 33. Should I bring my laptop?

A: Students can bring their laptops if they wish.
