Admission Policy

1. Purpose:

This policy upholds the vision and mission of Sohail University to ensure academic excellence and encourage an atmosphere of diversity and belonging for all the students getting admitted to the university. It depicts the University's commitment to equality in education and will lead to efficient management of all student admissions by exercising transparency and fairness for all the applicants.

Sohail University intends to provide learning opportunities to attract the best students, irrespective of their background, and prepare them to be confident citizens and potential leaders in an increasingly globalised work environment.

2. Scope:

This policy is applicable to all the undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate level programs offered by Sohail University.

3. Policy Statement:

Sohail University is open to all persons of any sex of whatever religion, race, creed, class color or domicile who are academically qualified for admissions to the courses of study offered by the university and no such person will be denied the privilege on the ground of sex, religion, cast, creed, domicile, class, color.

Admission to the various academic programs of the university will be granted to all the candidates through a fair, consistent, and transparent selection process. Admission requirements for programs shall be based on the criteria set by the respective professional/ accrediting bodies and the decisions will be made by those equipped and authorized to make the required judgments.

4. Responsibilities:

The University's Students Affairs department in collaboration with the University authorities and Deans and Heads of Programs is responsible for ensuring that policies and procedures regarding student selection and admissions are implemented with fairness and are aligned with the University's strategic aims and objectives.
