Meeting Overview

The 3rd meeting of the SCALE (Student Council for Academic Learning Enhancement) was conducted with active participation from the Lead Student Representative (LSR), Deputy LSR, and SCALE members. The session included both physical and online attendees, reflecting a hybrid engagement approach.

1. Opening Session

The meeting commenced with a welcome note from the Chair, who acknowledged the presence of all participants. The Director QEC informed the forum that the LSR is scheduled to present a refined version of the discussion in the upcoming IQC meeting on **14th April 2026**.

2. LSR Presentation

The Lead Student Representative delivered a comprehensive presentation, as directed in the previous meeting. The presentation focused on:

- Identification of key academic and administrative challenges
- Practical solutions to address highlighted issues
- Strategic initiatives for future development

3. Key Issues Identified

The meeting identified several general institutional challenges, including concerns related to academic integrity, infrastructure limitations, technological constraints, and administrative processes, which collectively impact the overall learning environment and student experience. To address these areas, it was proposed to strengthen monitoring and accountability mechanisms, enhance infrastructure and technological support, adopt modern learning approaches, and streamline administrative systems to ensure improved efficiency and quality of education.

5. Future Action Plan

The forum outlined a forward-looking plan to enhance student engagement and institutional development:

- Organization of inter-university events (research, sports, and gaming)
- Conducting seminars and workshops with industry professionals
- Hosting university events to promote public engagement and partnerships
